<p>They mostly used the colours blue, black, red, green, and gold in their paintings.</p> <p>A lot of Egyptian art depicted the pharaohs. This was often in a religious sense as the pharaohs were considered gods.</p> <p>Many of the paintings of Ancient Egypt survived for so many thousands of years because of the extremely dry climate of the area.</p> <p>A sketch may serve a number of purposes: it might record something that the artist sees, it might record or develop an idea for later use or it might be used as a quick way of graphically demonstrating an image, idea or principle.</p> <p>The artistic style captures the viewer with emotion and intrigue. Proportion	the dimensions of a composition and relationships between height, width and depth.
Pattern	a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated
Inspire	an unconscious burst of creativity in a literary, musical, or visual art and other artistic endeavours.
Sketch	a rapidly executed freehand drawing that is not usually intended as a finished work.
Abstract	a form of art with no recognisable subject, it doesn't represent images of our everyday lives
