Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Key word	Definition
Col legno	A way of playing a stringed instrument by striking the string with the wooden part of the bow.
Haiku	A Japanese three line poem which has a strict syllable structure of 5,7,5.
Improvising	Making up music as it is played or performed
Melody	Notes of different pitches played in a sequence to create a tune
Inspiration	Something that encourages you to be creative
Duration	The length of time each note is played for - long or short
Pitch	How high or low a sound is
Dynamics	The volume of music- loud or quiet
Timbre	The quality of sound e.g. smooth, scratchy, twinkly
Structure	How the music is organised into different sections
Texture	How many layers of sound the music has- thick or thin
Tempo	The speed of the music - fast or slow
