

| Key word                    | Definition  |
| Rights                      | Those things that one is morally or legally entitled to do or have  |
| Responsibilities            | Duties  |
| Citizen                     | Someone who is a citizen of a particular country is legally accepted as belonging to that country   |
| Prejudice                   | Prejudice is an unreasonable dislike of a particular group of people or things  |
| Refugee                     | Refugees are people who have been forced to leave their homes or their country, either because there is a war there or because of their political or religious beliefs. |
| Persecution                 | Persecution is cruel and unfair treatment of a person or group, especially because of their religious or political beliefs, or their race                               |
| Conflict                    | Conflict is fighting between countries or groups of people  |
| Asylum                      | If a government gives a person from another country asylum, they allow them to stay, usually because they are unable to return home safely for political reasons        |
