<div data-bbox="118 336 226 448"></div> <p>Ernest Shackleton (1874—1922) Irish explorer who led three expeditions to the Antarctic, including Endurance.</p> <div data-bbox="107 491 197 612"></div> <p>Robert Falcon Scott (1868—1912) A royal navy officer and explorer who led two expeditions to the Antarctic regions.</p> <div data-bbox="114 651 300 751"></div> <p>(1944-present) Ranulph Fiennes. He is the first and only person to circumnavigate the whole planet through both the north and south pole. In 1993 he became the first man to WALK across the whole continent of Antarctica, unsupported. It took him <i>just</i> 93 days.</p>
