Are You Applying for School/Academy Places for September 2023??

Do you have a child who has a 4^{th} birthday between 1^{st} September 2023 and 31^{st} August 2024, or is his/her last year of Primary School from 1^{st} September 2023?? - then for Lancashire resident families you need to apply for a school place, even if an older brother or sister is already attending your preferred school/academy.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at: www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (or simply click here).

This already went live on 1st September 2023. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application.

The closing dates for applications for September 2024 are at 11-59 pm on:-

Secondary school applications - 31st October 2023

Primary school applications - 15th January 2024

Children's Attendance at THT

At THT our Attendance for the last academic year was 92.4% for the academic year - 96% is the target!! Of the more 'common' absences:

3.4% were ill

0.3% were medical appointments

0.2% were on an authorised holiday and

0.6% were on an unauthorised holiday. Other absences were recorded.

At THT were are taking a much firmer approach to attendance for 2023 - 2024 academic year - in line with Government expectations.

Please remember that holidays during term time cannot be authorised (unless for very exceptional circumstances) and any illnesses or medical appointments count as an absence if a child is not present at school during registration times. I know this sounds harsh - but is in line with Lancashire Attendance Policy. (Click here for more details.) Once a term our new Pupil Attendance Support Worker will be visiting the school - and we will be inviting any parents or carers into school where attendance is lower than expected - to give advice or strategies on how it can be improved.

As we used to in the past (before COVID), we will reward those children who manage to gain 100% each term with a certificate - and if they manage 100% attendance for the year - they will receive a medal. The highest attaining classes for each week (as always) will be congratulated on the Newsletter and the highest attending class for each term will receive a Non Uniform Day as a reward!!
