COVID Cases at THT

As I stated on the letter sent out to you yesterday, you may have noticed that staff are once again wearing masks / visors in and around school.

I'm afraid that the number of positive cases at THT has risen over the weekend and we have a few staff and children who have tested positive for COVID 19.

Mr Skinner and Mrs Flowers have tested positive as has Mrs Birkby. Miss Iddon tested positive last weekend and is still isolating, and a small number of children in Years 1, 4, 5 and 6 have gone for PCR due to positive lateral flows test results. Seven children have since had their results returned as positive. Please note that if you are suspecting that your child has symptoms (or we notice them in school) - please book a PCR test ASAP. Mr Skinner and one child in Year 6 did not test positive on a lateral flow test - but did on the PCR.

Due to the rising numbers, we have also made the following decisions about the running of the school for the next two weeks (longer if needed):

- Please can we ask parents / carers / grandparents to wear a face covering (mask / visor etc) when
 on the school grounds (unless you are exempt).
- Please limit coming into school as much as possible i.e. phone or email the office rather than 'popping in'.
- For the next 2 weeks we are cancelling all face to face IEP (Individual Education Plan) meetings these will be done by phone call instead.
- Next Wednesday's Parents' Evening will be done by phone instead of Face to Face.
- Whole School Worship will revert to 'recorded' Acts of Worship which can be played in classrooms rather than gathering together in the hall. We will also be asking parents / family members not to attend Celebration Worship.
- All after school clubs (football / netball / Ninja Club etc) are cancelled for the time being.
- All community clubs are also cancelled (Yoga, Hiit Classes and Women's Institute).
- Before and After School Club will continue as normal but will revert to a bubble system.
- We are not (as yet) running 'bubbles' in school but may have to move to this if needed.

We hope these restrictions will only be in place, as I said, for the next two weeks - but of course this may change according to the number of cases at THT. Talking to other 'Heads' in the area - numbers of positive cases in Primary Schools seems to be on the rise at the moment, so 'watch this space'.

Extra Holiday for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee

Don't forget, THT will be closed on Friday 26th November in honour of Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee. If you remember (Newsletter 1 of this year), to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, there is to be an extra Bank Holiday for the 2021/22 academic year. The date set for the Country is Friday 3rd June 2022. However, as many schools are already on holiday during this time, schools are allowed to designate another day during the year to mark the holiday. We have therefore chosen to have a longer weekend in November to break up the long Autumn term.

Children in Need

The BBC Children in Need Appeal takes place this Friday (19th November). The new School Council and Year 5 have asked if the Children could dress up with a theme of 'Superheroes' on the day...but if not...any Non Uniform will do. The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:-

www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (then click on School Admissions and "Apply for a school place")

This went live on 1^{st} September 2021. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications.

Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application.

The closing dates for applications for September 2022 are at 11-59 pm on:-
