COVID Cases at THT

As I stated in my letter to you last Friday, the rising numbers of positive COVID cases at THT seems to have slowed - and staff / children are beginning to return to school after their periods of isolation.

However, for this week (at least) - the following restrictions will continue to be in place:

- Please can we ask parents / carers / grandparents to wear a face covering (mask / visor etc) when on the school grounds (unless you are exempt).
- School staff are to wear masks / face coverings in the communal areas of the school.
- With regard to visitors and parents, please limit coming into school as much as possible i.e. phone or email the office rather than 'popping in'.
- For the next week we are cancelling all face to face IEP (Individual Education Plan) meetings these will be done by phone call instead.
- Parents' Evenings will all be done by phone instead of Face to Face.
- The Friends Christmas Market has been cancelled (see later in the letter).
- Whole School Worship continues to be recorded which can be played in classrooms rather than gathering together in the hall.
- All after school clubs (football / netball / Ninja Club etc) are cancelled for the time being. WLSP will continue as normal...unless you hear from us.
- All community clubs are also cancelled (Yoga, Hiit Classes and Women's Institute).
- Before and After School Club will continue as normal but will revert to a bubble system.
- We are keeping Year 4 and Year 6 as isolated bubbles this week.
 - At the start of the day Year 4 will enter school using the main entrance and Year 6 will come through the door between my office and the staffroom. They will also use these entrances at the end of the day. (Please can Year 6 come through the churchyard rather than down the side of the school.)

Year 4 will have morning break at 10.40am - Year 6 at 11am

Year 4 will have lunch at usual time and play on the area just outside the Junior Entrance Year 6 will have lunch from 12.30 until 1.00 – and will then play out on the Junior Yard until 1.30pm

We hope these restrictions will only continue for this week - but of course this may change according to the number of positive COVID cases at THT.

The reassuring thing is that I had a phone conversation with Public Health England during the latter part of last week, and they were happy with all the measures that THT has in place during this time.

Extra Holiday for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee

Don't forget, THT will be <u>closed this Friday, 26th November</u>, in honour of Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee.

If you remember, to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, there is to be an extra Bank Holiday for the 2021/22 academic year. The date set for the Country is Friday 3rd June 2022. However, as many schools are already on holiday during this time, schools are allowed to designate another day during the year to mark the holiday. We have therefore chosen to have a longer weekend in November to break up the long Autumn term.

Parents' Evening

The Autumn Term Parents' Evening will take place this week, on Wednesday 24th November and Thursday 25th November. We hope that the evening will prove to be useful and informative for you. All the meetings will be done by phone call. If you miss the call - please do not call back or try and contact school as the teachers will move onto the next person on the list and then try you again. Please note that as some of the teachers will be using their personal mobile phones, your phone may display 'unknown number' or 'Caller ID Unknown' when they ring.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:-

Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application. The closing dates for applications for September 2022 are at 11-59 pm on:-
