Time is Running Out...Are You Applying for School/Academy Place(s) for September 2017??

Do you have a child who has a 4th birthday between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017? - then for Lancashire resident families you need to apply for a school place, even if an older brother or sister is already attending your preferred school/academy.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:-

www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (then click on "Apply for a school place")

It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application. The closing dates for Primary school applications for September 2017 are at 11-59 pm on 15th January 2017.

During last week, 152 (out of 172) of our children managed to achieve 100% attendance - they didn't miss one day of school!! The 'best attending class of the week' was a tie between Mrs Dimmock's Year 2 Class - 99.5% attendance for the week!! During the same week five children were late for at least one session of school.
