With regards to the Infant Nativity performances on Wednesday and Thursday evening this week, after our dress rehearsal today, we are anticipating that the show will run for about 45 minutes.

Therefore, please can parents / carers of children not attending the performances come to school's main entrance at 7:30pm to collect your children if you are not already at the performance. The front door will be opened and then please make your way to the School Hall to collect your child. All children will be collected from the school hall, including children whose parents/carers are watching the performance in the hall.

The children will need a few minutes to get changed out of their costumes before they go home and we will need to ensure that all of the children are collected safely.

Visiting the children in their classrooms or taking your child immediately after the performance is NOT allowed due to safeguarding.

Please bear with us during this time. The safety and security of the children is paramount and it is a once-a-year event so we appreciate your patience and understanding with this.

Are You Applying for School/Academy Places for September 2023??

Do you have a child who has a 4th birthday between 1st September 2022 and 31st August 2023 - then for Lancashire resident families you need to apply for a Primary School place, even if an older brother or sister is already attending your preferred school/academy.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:-

www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (or simply click here).

This already went live on 1st September 2022. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application.

The closing dates for Primary applications for September 2023 are at 11-59 pm on 15th January 2023.
