According to the website, around 500,000 people took part in the last birdwatch. That's a LOT of birds counted!

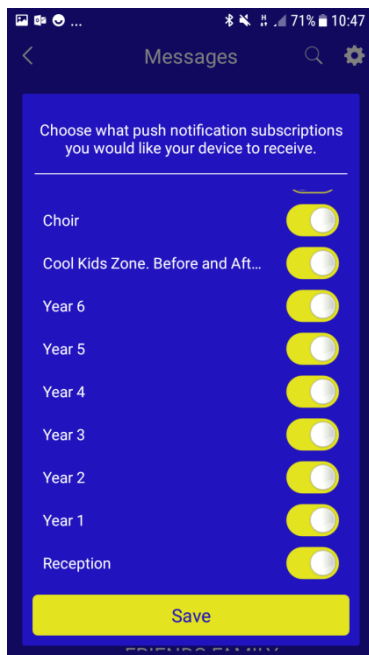
