Did you know...

During the half term break it is Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day.

Shrove Tuesday (sometimes called Pancake day) is the day in February or March immediately preceding Ash Wednesday (the first day of Lent), which is celebrated in some countries by

consuming pancakes. In others, especially those where it is called *Mardi Gras* or some translation thereof, this is a carnival day, and also the last day of "fat eating" or "gorging" before the fasting period of Lent. Valentine's Day, also called Saint Valentine's Day or the Feast of Saint Valentine, is an annual holiday celebrated on February 14th. It originated as a Western Christian liturgical feast day honouring one or more early saints named *Valentinus*, and is now recognized as a significant cultural and commercial celebration in many regions around the world.
