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Wednesdays During Lent

It is a tradition at THT that during Lent, the Wednesday morning worship is celebrated in church rather than in school. This happens every Wednesday morning starting tomorrow, on Wednesday 22nd February which is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. The services will be led by Father Mark or Danny Abraham.

Parents / Grandparents / Family Members are more than welcome to join us for the services. We hope to see you there!! Each service starts at 9.05 (ish) and should be finished by 9.30am.

World Book Day

World Book Day 2023 takes place on Thursday 2 March and we hope you'll join us as we come together to celebrate our World Book Day in school, and at Tarleton Holy Trinity we like to extend World Book Day into what we call Reading Week.

We will have lots of fun activities taking place throughout the week!!

On Monday, Year 6 children will read to Year 3, whilst Year 5 read to Year 2 and Year 4 read to Year 1. On Tuesday the teachers will 'Share their favourite Story' with another class and Year 6 Buddies will read to their 'Buddlings' in Mrs Warburton's Reception Class

On Wednesday the children will be invited to 'Stop and Read' when the school bell is rung during the day. Scholastic Book Fair will be open in the hall 3.40-4.15pm

On Thursday, the children in each class will be working with their class teacher to enhance their class reading area. Scholastic Book Fair open in hall 3.40-4.15pm

And on Friday - we will have a different type of 'Dress Up Day'.

As usual the children can wear a costume depicting their favourite book character that has been bought or made using things you already have at home.

OR - the children can come dressed in 'What they usually wear when reading for pleasure at home'. (This could be, for example, pyjamas)

OR- the children can make a large badge to wear representing their book character.

This year we will not be giving prizes for the 'Best Costume' or 'Best Dressed Child'. Instead, there will be one prize per Class for the child who has worked the hardest to promote reading and generally been the most enthusiastic 'Book Worm' during our THT 2023 Reading Week.




A Kind Donation

Tomorrow is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent.

Lent is the period of 40 days which comes before Easter in the Christian calendar (the 40 days doesn't include Sundays). It is a season of reflection and preparation before the celebrations of Easter. By observing the 40 days of Lent, Christians replicate Jesus Christ's sacrifice and withdrawal into the desert for 40 days.
