Commonwealth Games, Birmingham 2022. It takes place throughout the week of Monday 28th February to Friday 4th March.


A baton and banner will travel around 57 schools in West Lancashire and will finish on the Friday afternoon at Mossy Lea Primary. They will then hand over to the Chorley District on Monday morning 7^{th} March for the baton to continue its journey around Lancashire.

The baton and banner starts with Bretherton Endowed CE Primary School who will bring them to THT at about 9.30am. We then take part in the relay, handing the baton and banner to pupil from Tarleton Academy.

THT, Bretherton and Tarleton Academy will form part of a short opening ceremony by the SPAR Lancashire School Games Organising Committee, as we have the honour of being the first District EnRoute to the Lancashire Finals in July.

How can I celebrate Twosday?

If you're stuck for ideas on how to celebrate Twosday, here are some quick activities you can try out with children at home:

- Learn the two times table. This could involve memorisation, songs, head-to-head challenges, <u>practice worksheets</u>, and more. Twosday is definitely the best time to dedicate an hour (or two) to this.
- Challenge kids to read two books. You can carry on this task after today to give children plenty of time to finish off the reading challenge. Older students can write a book report comparing and contrasting the two books.
- Design a picture out of 2D shapes. Squares, circles, triangles, rectangles, parallelograms no matter what shape it is, they're all 2D, and that makes them perfect for a Twosday activity.
