are not allowed to attend.

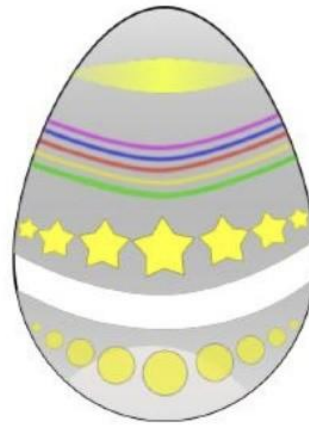
