Cost of 'Paid For' School Meals

There has been an increase to the catering charges that school receives in respect of inflationary rises. Therefore, the School Governors and I have taken the decision to increase the price for KS2 meals (Years 3 to 6) from £2.35 to £2.40. This will take effect from the first day back after the Easter Break - Monday 25th April 2022.

What Is Daylight Saving Time?

DST is a seasonal time change measure where clocks are set ahead of standard time during part of the year, usually by 1 hour. As DST starts, the Sun rises and sets later, on the clock, than the day before. Today, about 40% of countries worldwide use it to make better use of daylight and to conserve energy.
