### Did you know...

The fish on next week's menu (see above) is labelled as 'Harry Ramsdens'.

Three Did you knows for the price of one...

- 1. The original Harry Ramsden's Fish and Chip shop/restaurant was located just outside Guiseley in West Yorkshire (3 miles from where I lived as a child)...and the name had an apostrophe in it...Harry Ramsden's. It opened in 1928 (as a wooden hut) and the larger shop / restaurant eventually closed on 19th December 2011.
- 2. The shop held many world records during its time including the largest fish and chip shop in the world and the most portions of fish and chips served in one day (over 10,000) in 1952!!
- 3. Harry Ramsden's nephew, Harry Corbett, who played the piano at the restaurant in its day, later became the famous creator of Sooty and Sweep.
