Findings from our Parent Questionnaire Spring 2024

During our Spring Term 'Face to Face' Spring Parents' evenings, I invited as many parents / carers as possible to complete a Parent Questionnaire. This is based on the Questions as by [Parent view](#) - the platform that Ofsted use when they are Inspecting Schools and seeking the views of Parents.

120 questionnaires were completed over the course of the 2 nights, and over the next few weeks I will 'talk you through' the results.

Question 3 asked for your response to the statement: 'The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.'



Only 1 parent/carer said that they disagreed, with 3 saying that they 'didn't know'.

I know that, on occasions, our children are not always the 'Angels' we would like them to be - but I think that they know the school rules well and try as much as they can to keep the THT Family happy.

When Ofsted last visited us in July 2023, they stated that, 'Pupils behave well and are respectful and polite towards others. They strive to follow the school's golden rules for positive behaviour, which include 'always being polite, kind and respectful to everyone' and 'trying as hard as we can in everything we do'. Pupils benefit from well-embedded routines that support their learning and behaviour. Learning is not disrupted due to poor behaviour.'

With regard to the Questionnaire, the other 96% of parents / carers (who completed a questionnaire) agreed that 'The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.'

There again, the one parent who disagreed I had a chat with one the evening and fully appreciate the reasons for their answer.
