Findings from our Parent Questionnaire Spring 2023

During our 'Face to Face' Spring Parents' evening, 70 questionnaires were completed on the night. The questions / statements are that same that are asked by Ofsted on 'Parent View'.

Question 2 asked for your response to the statement: 'My child feels safe at school.'

Only 2 parent/carers disagreed with this statement.

We have a large perimeter fence around the school to keep the children safe - and each break time we have at least 2 members of staff on duty per Key Stage.

During a recent pupil interview that I carried out with some of the children in school - all the children named at least one member of staff who they would call on if they were worried. 3 children actually said that they would come to me if it was 'really important'.

Miss Jagger or I are also usually outside of the school at the beginning and at the end of the school day – Just in Case...
