Are You Applying for School/Academy Places for September 2017??

Do you have a child who has a 4th birthday between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017, or is his/her last year of Primary School from 1st September 2016?? - then for Lancashire resident families you need to apply for a school place, even if an older brother or sister is already attending your preferred school/academy.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:-

www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (then click on "Apply for a school place")

This already went live on 1^{st} September 2016. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications.

Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application.

The closing dates for applications for September 2017 are at 11-59 pm on:-

Secondary school applications - 31st October 2016

Primary school applications - 15th January 2017
