Findings from our Parent Questionnaire Spring 2023

During our 'Face to Face' Spring Parents' evening, 70 questionnaires were completed on the night. The questions / statements are that same that are asked by Ofsted on 'Parent View'.

Question 5 asked for your response to the statement: 'The School makes sure it's pupils are well behaved.' 100% of parent/carers agreed with this statement - you can't get better than that!!

Question 4 asked for your response to the statement: 'The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.'

4 parents disagreed with this - and another said that they didn't know.

At THT we start each year with a 'Meet the Teacher' evening - where the class teachers highlight the topics which are going to be covered during the year and routines of the week etc.

On our School Website we also display our Curriculum Overviews for each Class which highlights the themes and topics for each class during the year. Something new this year (on the Website) are our Knowledge Organisers (KOs). The KO guides pupils through the subject, reminding them of what they have already learned, what vocabulary they will be learning and Key Questions which will be answered during the topic. The Key Questions are the 'End Goals' and 'Finishing Points' of each topic / unit.
