## Findings from our Parent Questionnaire Spring 2023

During our 'Face to Face' Spring Parents' evening, 70 questionnaires were completed on the night. The questions / statements are that same that are asked by Ofsted on 'Parent View'.

Question 6 asked for your response to the statement: 'When I have raised concerns with the school, they have been dealt with properly.'

1 person disagreed with this and 2 said that they 'didn't know'.

The School has to follow some protocol when dealing with some concerns - but for the large part of the time, either I or Miss Jagger deal with concerns as quickly as possible, either by a face to face meeting, a phone call - then if not an email / Dojo message. As far as I know, all concerns have been dealt with in a timely manner and have reached a positive conclusion - so I am confused that 1 person disagrees...

Question 7 asked for your response to the statement: 'My child has SEND and the school gives them they support they need to succeed"

1 parent disagreed with this - and 12 said that they didn't know.

At Parents' Evenings and IEP Meetings (IEP = Individual Education Plan) teachers discuss how children with SEND are progressing and how interventions and classroom support are working.

In 2023 - Miss Jagger has been taking great care to 'hand over' the SENDCO role to Mrs Warburton and meetings often, at the moment, involve the both of them - so parents and carers are getting 'two for the price of one!!'
