

## AN EXPLANATION OF THE SUMMER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The Summer School is organised by Kevin Corcoran, a qualified teacher with experience of running many Summer Schools in the past.

The aim of the Summer School is to provide meaningful activities from which the children will gain learning, improvement and enjoyment.

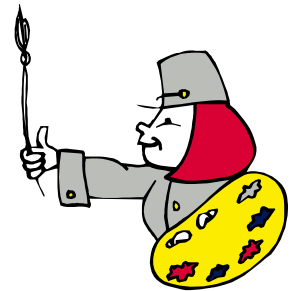
### RECREATIONAL GYMNASTICS (Kevin Corcoran)

These 2 hour sessions are designed for boys and girls, aged 5 years and over, to provide a broad range of gymnastics experience. Each session consists of a warm up, five activities, and a cool down. There are lots of activities to choose from, including: Floorwork, Vault, Dance, Acrobatics, Beam, Trampoline, Bars, Rhythmic, Pommel, Bench, Rings and Airtrack. The maximum class size is 30 gymnasts. Kevin is a qualified coach with many years experience in Gymnastics, and will be assisted by a team of coaches.



### ART and CRAFT (Charlotte Smith)

In these 2 hour sessions the children will be given the instruction, resources and support to help them produce a work of art which will be of their own making and worthy of taking home. The class is suitable for children of 5 years and over, and there will be a maximum of 32 places. Charlotte is training to be a teacher and has several years experience of planning and leading our Art and Craft sessions. She will be assisted by Kevin and a team of coaches.



### BALL GAMES (Kevin Corcoran)

In these 2 hour sessions the children will practise skills and play games in a range of indoor ball games, such as Football, Basketball, Netball, Unihoc, Handball, Cricket, Mat ball and Rounders. The class has 20 places and is most suitable for children over 7 years, but we will accommodate children over 5 years if necessary. Kevin is a P.E. teacher with experience in Primary and Secondary schools.



### DRAMA (Charlotte Smith)

These 2 hour sessions are suitable for children over 5 years and will take place in the School Hall. The children will experience a range of Drama activities prepared and delivered by Charlotte. Charlotte belongs to a local dramatic society, has performed in plays and musicals, and led our sessions successfully last year. She will be assisted by Kevin and a team of coaches.
