Attendance

The Government have announced that tighter restrictions will once again be in place for children's punctuality and attendance in school.

This year - we have not been as strict on what time children arrive (as we know that during COVID, parents had to drop their children off at different times and at different doors etc).

We also appreciate that some family holidays which were cancelled during the pandemic have had to be taken during term time due to restrictions from the holiday companies.

However, from September onwards, holidays which are not deemed as exceptional will be unauthorised and you may incur a fine.

We would also like children to try and arrive as near to 8.45am as possible, and definitely no later than 8.55am - as arriving later than this impacts on their learning and curriculum time in school.

If you arrive after 8.55am - you are not usually settled in class by 9.00am - which means you have already missed 5 minutes of learning.

If a child does this every day during the school year - the child would miss nearly 3 days of school. Their attendance would officially be 98.4% for the year - without taking any other days off.
