#### COVID Vaccinations in the area...

West Lancashire Borough Council and West Lancashire Partnership are organising a number of pop up vaccination clinics across the Borough with no appointment needed. (See the poster below...)

There is also a COVID Vaccine Bus coming to Tarleton on Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup> at St Marks Square between 10am and 4pm. Bookings for this are not required and vaccines are available for anyone over 18. If attending for your 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination, please ensure that it is at least 8 weeks after the first vaccination jab.

#### Sports Day 2021
