COVID Vaccinations in the area...

A reminder that West Lancashire Borough Council and West Lancashire Partnership are organising a number of pop up vaccination clinics across the Borough with no appointment needed. (See the poster below...)

There is also a COVID Vaccine Bus coming to Tarleton on Saturday July 10th at Mark Square between 10am and 4pm. Bookings for this are not required and vaccines are available for anyone over 18. If attending for your 2nd vaccination, please ensure that it is at least 8 weeks after the first vaccination jab.

Sports Day 2021

A reminder that this week (Week Beginning Monday 5th July (weather permitting) starts our 'Sports Day Week'. Information has come from the Government that, as long as we stick to our 'Bubbles', we can run a Sports Day - or Sports Day Events.

Break the Rules Day

On Friday 9th July Friends PTA would like to invite each child the chance to break some school rules for the day!

Children can choose to break up to 5 rules. The 'fine' for each rule broken will be 50p. Children should bring their fine in a sealed, named envelope and give it to their class teacher. Apart from 5 of the chosen Rules to break...the rest of the School Rules still apply as always.
