Are You Applying for School/Academy Places for September 2024??

Do you have a child who has a 4^{th} birthday between 1^{st} September 2023 and 31^{st} August 2024, or is his/her last year of Primary School from 1^{st} September 2023?? - then for Lancashire resident families you need to apply for a school place, even if an older brother or sister is already attending your preferred school/academy.

The means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at:www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools (or simply click here).

The website already went live on 1st September 2023. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your on-line application.

The closing dates for applications for September 2024 are at 11-59 pm on:-Secondary school applications - 31st October 2023 Primary school applications - 15th January 2024

For prospective parents, or indeed anyone who is interested in life at THT, our Open Day for this year is on Wednesday 18th October, with both afternoon and evening sessions.

If your child is to start Primary School in 2025 - Open Day might be a good opportunity to have an early look at THT as choosing the right Primary School for your child can sometimes be a difficult choice. We hope to see you there!!
