Did you know...

Some of our children arrive bang on 8.45am, walk into class and start their morning tasks. Although we officially start at 8.55am - by then - the 'early bird children' will have already done 10 minutes of work, which over a school year adds up to 6.5 extra days of work.

Similarly - if your child arrives 5 minutes late each day - they officially miss 3.17 days of school over a year - but in reality do 9.5 days less work than the 'early birds'!! Being punctual really does help your child's education.
