If your child manages to achieve 95% or more for the year, you get a 'Green' attendance letter from school and have achieved the LCC attendance target.

90% attendance would give you a 'Yellow' letter – but 'Did You Know' that 90% attendance means your child has missed $\frac{1}{2}$ a day a week or has missed a month of school during the academic year.
