<u>Attendance Figures</u> - 143 of our children (that's 89%) managed to achieve 100% attendance. During the same week just two children were late for school for at least one session. 2015 Parent Questionnaire Findings...

This is the next 'instalment' of what the results of our Parent Questionnaire told us:

Question 4 asked you to respond to the statement, 'The School helps me to support my child's learning'. 96% of you agreed with this (a 2% increase on last year), 3% responded as 'Didn't know' and 1 parent stated that they disagreed.

In addition to the Parents' Evenings that we put on every term (see last week's newsletter), at the beginning of each school year, the teachers invite all parents and carers to attend a 'Meet the Teacher' evening. This is an informal meeting where parents and carers are invited into school to discuss the routines etc. in your child's new class. Each term our class teachers will also complete a topic letter so you know are aware of what your child /children will be focussing on each term.

This year we have also invited parents and carers to a Phonics evening and a Maths Calculations evening to assist parents and carers in helping their children at home...that's quite a lot that we do to help you to support your child's learning!!

<u>EU Referendum - 23rd June 2016</u> - This is an early warning that THT will have to close on the 23rd June as it is being used as a Polling Station for the EU Referendum. As the EU vote has been announced during this year and the term dates are set, we will not have to open for an extra day elsewhere. So the holiday pattern stays as it is and just an extra one day closure on the 23rd June.
