2016 Parent Questionnaire Findings...

The next response to the questionnaire... Question 11 asked parents and carers to respond to the statement: 'This school is led and managed effectively'. 98% of you agreed with this... and three of you (2%) responded as 'Didn't know'.

All I can say is that I hope I am doing a good job and as a team we are getting Tarleton Holy Trinity to where I want it to be...the 'preferred school in the area'.

Many of your comments during our recent parents' evening were very positive and during our most recent inspections, they used phrases such as, 'The headteacher's high expectations and uncompromising drive to improve teaching, learning and standards is shared by staff and governors' (Ofsted 2013) and '...the recently appointed headteacher has had an immediate and positive impact, which is recognised by all members of the school family. All feel included and valued'. (SIAMs 2014)

I strongly feel that my senior leadership team is also working well (and very hard) to move the school forward on its continuous search for improvement, and there again, Ofsted said that, '...senior leaders have taken decisive actions to bring about 'non-negotiable' improvements in teaching. As a result, teaching is improving and attainment rising.

...and the Governors are doing everything in their power to ensure that the school is 'ever improving' with Ofsted giving them a very complementary paragraph on page 6 of their final report.

Developments at THT

In an attempt to remove all cash and cheques from school we are asking all parents and carers to use our new e-payment method to pay for school dinners. This can be done online using a very secure website called 'ParentPay' or in cash where you see the PayPoint logo.

On Wednesday you will receive a letter with all the information you need on how to register with 'ParentPay'. This is a new system for the Office and ask for your patience as we go through the set up process. This will hopefully make payment for dinner money more efficient. We will extend this service for all other payments to school in due course but will keep you informed.
